

DISTRICT COUNCIL CONNECTION WHO CAN VOTE??

ELIGIBLE VOTERS:

1. ***Ordained Ministers*** in good standing
2. ***Licensed Ministers*** in good standing
3. ***Certified Ministers serving as senior pastors*** and in good standing
4. ***Delegates:***
 - General Council churches may designate two delegates
 - District affiliated churches may designate one delegate
5. ***Non-credentialed members*** of boards, committees, and teams
6. ***Non-credentialed Senior Pastors of General Council churches***
7. ***Non-credentialed Senior Pastors of District affiliated churches***

NON VOTERS:

- ✓ Certified Ministers who are NOT senior pastors
- ✓ Visitors

Assemblies of God, Northern California and Nevada District Council, Inc. BYLAWS

ARTICLE TWO – MEMBERSHIP MEETINGS, VOTING CONSTITUENCY

Section One: Voting Constituency

- A. The voting constituency for all meetings of the membership of this District Council in session shall consist of all accredited members present and registered, and participating in the business being conducted.
- B. The term accredited members shall include the following:
 1. Ordained Ministers in good standing holding current ministerial credentials registered with this District Council;
 2. Licensed Ministers in good standing holding current ministerial credentials registered with this District Council;
 3. Persons holding current Certificates of Ministry in good standing and serving as senior pastor of an affiliated Assemblies of God church in this District Council shall be recognized as though they were licensed ministers for purpose of registration and participation as part of the voting constituency in business session meetings of the membership of this District Council;
 4. Churches within the geographical territory of this District Council that have been issued a letter of affiliation from The General Council of the Assemblies of God, having current status as a sovereign Assemblies of God church may be represented by two designated non-credentialed delegates and each District Council affiliated church may be recognized by one designated non-credentialed delegate.
 5. Non-credentialed persons who are regular members of boards and standing committees of this District Council shall be accorded the privilege of voice and vote in membership sessions of this District Council.
 6. Non-credentialed persons approved by the Executive Committee to serve as senior pastors of General Council affiliated assemblies shall be accorded the privilege of voice and vote in membership sessions of this District Council.
 7. Non-credentialed persons appointed by the District Churches and District Missions Board to serve as senior pastors of District Council affiliated assemblies, shall be accorded the privilege of voice and vote in membership sessions of this District Council.
